## AIR NAVIGATION SERVICE PROVIDER CERTIFICATE

Pursuant to Regulation (EC) No 550/2004 of the European Parliament and the Council of 10 March 2004 on the provision of air navigation services in the single European sky and Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No 1035/2011 of 17 October 2011 laying down common requirements for the provision of air navigation services and amending Regulations (EC) No 482/2008 and (EU) No 691/2010, it is hereby certified that:

In accordance with Article 7 (4) and Annex II of (EC) No 550/2004 the following conditions are attached to this certificate:

1. The certified ATS services concern the provision of TWR and APP services in respectively the ELLX CTR and TMAs.
2. The certified ANS services shall be provided in accordance with ICAO standards and recommended practices, Single European Sky legislation, national legislation, internal manuals, procedures and any conditions attached to the certificate.
3. For the certified ANS services, all correctives actions stemming from the oversight activities shall be implemented within the timeframe approved or otherwise extended by the DAC/NSA.
4. Any changes to the certified services or nominated post holders that may affect the certified services shall be notified in the due delay to the DAC/NSA.
5. Access to all relevant data shall be granted to the DAC/NSA and its working staff upon request.
6. Information required for the verification of compliance of the certified services with the applicable regulatory requirements shall be provided upon request to the DAC/NSA.
7. The certified service provider shall notify to the DAC the results of its internal occurrence investigations.
