OBJECTIVE

ANA as an organization is committed towards safety and therefore will set high-level objectives for a pro-active and systematic management of safety.

The ANA principal safety objective is to minimize as far as reasonably practicable its contribution to the risk of an accident while providing an expeditious service.

PRIORITY

ANA is committed to improve and achieve the highest possible safety standards, comply with all applicable legal requirements, meet all applicable standards and consider best practices, while providing adequate resources to achieve its safety goals.

ANA's Safety Management System encourages and has defined clear safety reporting principles and safety reporting procedures. These event reports are investigated with regard to ANA's Just culture policy.


MANAGEMENT

Safety is the primary responsibility of all managers and staff, and shall prevail over any pressure and constraints for commercial, operational, environmental and social interest, meaning also priority for training and resources. Heads of department are responsible for the safety performance of their own organizations.

COMMITMENT

ANA's senior management continually promote this safety policy to all personnel, in setting safety objectives and safety standards, while also providing adequate human and financial resources for its implementation and ensuring that proper level of competency is maintained.

This policy is periodically reviewed to ensure it remains relevant and appropriate.
